Get inspired by topics from at least one of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals described in the 2030 Agenda (world hunger, access to drinking water, etc.) and use the information you have found in the statistics.**

## **Who is launching the competition and why?**

This video competition has been launched by the Swiss Confederation in collaboration with the Swiss Council of Youth Activities on the occasion of the 3rd United Nations World Data Forum (UNWDF) to be held in Bern from 3 to 6 October 2021.

The competition is open to all youth club members and young people attending school in Switzerland (maximum age 18). The video competition on the Sustainable Development Goals is for two categories of participants (A and B, see below).

## **How to take part?**

**Category A: for 14 to 16 year-olds (born in 2005, 2006 or 2007)**

**Category B: for 17 to 18 year-olds (born in 2004 or 2003)**

Participants can register as a group with a maximum of 5 people. The videos should last max. 1min30. Video format: 16:9 (landscape).

All sources used must be clearly indicated.

## What's the prize?

Take part and win the following prizes:

- **Gift voucher worth CHF 500 (1st place), CHF 300 (2nd place) or CHF 100 (3rd place).**
- **A surprise gift for each of the participants, of different value depending on the place (1st, 2nd and 3rd place).**
- **A certificate for each of the participants.**

The five best videos from both categories will be published on the Road to Bern website and on the social media of the FSO, the Road to Bern as well as those of the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs (FDFA) dedicated to the 2030 Agenda.

We plan to award the winners of both categories with their prize during the opening ceremony of the UNWDF in Bern on 3 October 2021.

## When is the closing date?

We look forward to receiving your video, whether it is in French, German, Swiss-German, Italian, Romansh or English.
